FINAL DETAILS

Parking: Signed from SO 596754 on A4117.
 Parking is on land owned by Hanson Aggregates and we are extremely grateful to them. We are using a number of small pockets of land surrounding quarry workings and buildings. **Please stick to areas designated for our use and ensure children do not wander around any buildings, spoil heaps etc.** We have agreed a £1.00 parking charge (please have correct change ready upon arrival) which will be donated to the County Air Ambulance.

Directions: Take A4117 from either Kidderminster or Ludlow to road summit at Cleve Hill and follow minor road north to working quarries. Park as directed.

Terrain: Open rough moorland - mainly grass with areas of bracken, tussocks and marsh. Much mined with large quarries, spoil heaps, old buildings etc. on the top. Load and loads of bell pits on lower slopes. Few paths. Underlying terrain is smooth with few spurs or re-entrants.
