Directions: Take A4117 from either Kidderminster or Ludlow to road summit at Clee Hill and follow minor road north to working quarries.

Terrain: Open rough moorland - mainly grass with areas of bracken, tussocks and marsh. Much mined with large quarries, spoil heaps, old buildings etc. on the top. Load and loads of bell pits on lower slopes. Few paths. Underlying terrain is smooth with few spurs or re-entrants.
