- Venue:** Eastnor Park, Eastnor, Herefordshire. An area of open parkland with lakes, rising to woodland on the lower slopes of the Malvern Hills.

| White | Primary Years 5/6 Middle School Years 5/6 | Using paths, tracks and ditches to define the course. |
| Yellow | Secondary School Years 7/8 Middle School Years 7/8 | Using paths, tracks and ditches to define the course, with more decision points. |
| Orange | Secondary School Years 9/10 | Using features up to 10m away from line features such as paths. |
| Light Green | Secondary School Years 11/12/13 | Allowing for cross country navigation. |
- Event Details:** Competitors can enter individually or in pairs in each age class. Boys and girls will compete on the same course but will be separately classified in the results. Mixed pairs are allowed but they will have to run as boys. The courses will be planned to the lower end of British Orienteering guidelines for the appropriate colour. Sportident electronic punching will be used. Entry fee includes loan of an e-card.
- Awards:** Trophy for best school team on each course. A school team is defined as 4 runs on the course (a pair counts as 1 run). Pupils may run up one school year if necessary to fill a team. Medals for best boy or pair and girl or pair on each course. Certificates for all competitors.
- Fees:** £3.50 individual; £6.50 pair. Cheques payable to HOC.
