Venue & Travel:	5k NW of Bewdley, along the B4194. Car parking at Woodhouse Farm, Pound Green, DY12 3LD. Landranger Sheet 138 SO755784, signed from B4194.
Parking:	Flat grassy field. Limited hard standing available for coaches (please book in advance with organiser). Charge is £1 per car, £5 per coach.
Terrain:	A small hill of coniferous forest, with patches of mature, deciduous forest on the outer boundaries of the area. Along the eastern hillside many undulating valleys offer some interesting orienteering challenges, whilst fine-scale navigation is required where numerous adjacent gullies are present. The area has a good track and path network. Whilst parts of the area succumb to the West Midlands bramble curse, the planner has gone to some trouble to divert courses into the nicest areas, where the terrain is runnable.
Map:	Scale: 1:10,000, 5 m contours. Based on the 1993 map, survey by Alison Sloman and cartography by Colin Spears and on 1985 and 1990 maps by Harlequins Orienteering Club. Update by Alison Sloman 2006, 2008 and 2010.
Courses:	YBTF courses include Green, Light Green, Orange, Yellow. Local event courses include White, Yellow, Orange, Light Green, Green, Blue and Brown
YBTF entries:	Entry forms will be distributed to qualifying clubs in Nov. for advance entry
Registration:	Non-YBTF competitors: 09:30-11.00 (pre-entry available for orienteers in YBTF-qualifying clubs; entry details to be sent with YBTF entry forms) YBTF competitors: Pre-entry required. No entries on the day.
Starts:	Non-YBTF competitors, 10:00-11:30. YBTF competitors, 12.00-13:30. Courses close at 15:30
Punching:	Electronic punching using SportIdent (SI cards may be hired for £1.00)
Fees:	Seniors: £8 (£2 discount for British Orienteering members on production of membership card), juniors (including YBTF): £3
Facilities:	Portaloos in the car park Butcher's Grill Catering
