- Venue & Travel** Hawkbatch just off the B4194 at Buttonoak from where it will be O signed. Grid reference SO753779. Nearest post code DY12 3LG
- Parking:** Parking will be in a field forming part of Woodhouse Farm. If very wet / snowy in the preceding days / week please check [www.harlequins.org.uk](http://www.harlequins.org.uk) for any last minute changes.
- Terrain:** Hawkbatch is a Forestry Commission plantation of mixed woodland. There are some areas of quite technical contour detail but the majority of the map is open and runnable. There is also a good network of paths.
- Map:** A4 at 1:10,000 updated in 2010 by Alison Sloman (HOC). Courses will be overprinted onto a waterproof map.
- Courses:** White, Yellow, Orange, Light Green, Short Green, Green, Blue, Brown with course length going from approx 1.5 Km to 9km.
