- Venue:** Burlish Top and The Rifle Range, near Stourport-on-Severn.
- Parking:** Approach from the A451 Kidderminster-Stourport road, turning west into Walter Nash Road West by the traffic lights at GR SO818736, signed to Birchen Coppice Trading Estate. Assembly and free parking in 500m, by courtesy of The Music Group, at GR SO814737 (DY11 7HJ).
You may be directed to overflow parking in adjoining roads or neighbouring industrial units.
- Terrain:** Burlish Top Country Park has been developed on the site of a former wartime military hospital. The adjoining Rifle Range is mostly open heathland with some areas of naturally regenerated woodland. There are areas of brambles, broom and gorse. The area is relatively flat, with some grassy open areas, and an extensive path network.
- Map:** A4 size, 1:7,500 with 5m contours. Mapped by Paul Basher and David Williams. Pre-marked on water-resistant paper.
- Courses:** Score event with 60 minute time limit (45 minutes for juniors). See December AdHoc for details.
- Entries:** On the day only. This is a closed event for HOC members only.
- Registration:** 9.30 . 10.30hrs **Mass Start:** 11.00hrs (10.40 group walk to start)
- Punching:** Electronic Punching using SportIdent. Please bring your SI-card to registration. SI-cards may be hired for £1.
- Fees:** £4 for Seniors, £1 for Juniors
- Dogs:** Dogs welcome as long as they have well behaved owners.
- Facilities:** None. Please make yourself comfortable before you arrive!
