- Venue & Travel** Event Centre; The Little Packhorse, SO 787 741
Parking is at Gardners Meadow car park. If approaching Bewdley from the east, turn left immediately after going over bridge and carry straight on into the car park. If approaching from the west, turn right just before the bridge.
- Parking:** Normal town car park. No charge after 6pm. To the pub, leave the car park as you came in and turn left. Walk 100m up Lax Lane and turn right into a small private car park. Go up wooden steps.
- Terrain:** Hilly town divided by River Severn with Georgian centre.
- Map:** There will be three maps all A4; a photocopy of a jigsaw with a Victorian map of Bewdley, the A to Z map of Bewdley, vintage 2007, and the planner's hand drawn street map, vintage 2007
- Courses:** Short course will use the Victorian map and the A to Z map.
Medium course uses the Victorian map and the hand drawn map
Long course uses all three maps.
The course on the Victorian map will be normal street orienteering. The course on the hand drawn map will be a Russ event. The number at the control indicates which control to visit next.
- Entries:** Please use email fausetfam@aol.com or Harlequin forum to reserve maps. If food at the pub might be wanted, please inform by Monday 6th February
- Registration:** 1730 to 1900hrs **Starts:** 1800 - 1930 hrs.
- Punching:** Bring a red pen to record control codes. Electronic Punching using SportIdent will probably be used for start and finish. Please bring your SI-Card with you.
- Fees:** Seniors £4 Juniors £2
Juniors will need to be accompanied
- Dogs:** The Organiser would prefer no dogs
- Facilities:** Pub famous for Desperate Dan pies
