Congratulations to our champions, Russ Fauset, Andy White and John Leeson.

This year there were 6 events, which has been typical over the last few years. It seems unlikely that there will be a return to the 'old days' when there would be 9 or more events, including some in the south of HOC-land.

This year we had 44 different runners across all the events with quite a few from other clubs or none. However, although there were only 6 events there was just 1 person who attended all 6, a further 2 people did 5 events and another 4 competed in 4 events. Thus only 7 people completed the minimum number of 4 counting events for the league. The most at any event was 21 and the least just 10. Town centre events clearly attracted the most runners.

However, the long term viability of the league aside, the almost unanimous feeling among the runners was that these events are most enjoyable. They are exceptionally easy to organise and plan (especially if a free venue such as a pub can be found and openorienteeringmap is used) and those based in town centres are generally easily accessible by public transport. I hope that there will be continued interest to run another series of events next winter – all offers will be gratefully received 😊
