

SEDGLEY HALL FARM SEE

Thursday 10th July 2008

Sedgley Hall 'Farm' is a reasonably complex area of open space approximately half a kilometre square, bounded by housing.

It was mapped by Terry Foxton in 1987 at 1:5000 as part of an Orienteering project for Dudley, together with Himley and Cotwall End.

It has only been used for one event, also run by me, in 1987.

The original map will be used. No corrections will be displayed.

The area, however, hasn't changed too much, except that most fences are now vegetation boundaries and 3 playgrounds have been relocated. There is a good network of paths, some tarmacked, with mown verges. Other vegetation is rough in places.

The original permanent control posts will be used, of which 10 remain in amazingly good condition, together with about 8 SEE type controls.

Permanent controls tend to be on the edge of vegetation, which will be hacked back in a couple of cases to ease access and visibility as the time of year is not ideal.

Master maps will be provided for 3 loops, each of about 1.8k. The blue course will be all 3, green 2 only.

Starts are from 5.30 to 7pm
