Fibbersley lies on the Western edge of Willenhall.
From M6 Junction 10 follow the signs to Wolverhampton A 454 for 3.5m.
At the first traffic lights, by the BP garage, turn right to Wednesfield (Neachells Lane).
After 0.5m turn right into Watery Lane.
After 0.5m turn left at Island then right into car park (956992)

Fibbersley is one of a series of 6 areas in Walsall being mapped for permanent Orienteering courses. Watch out for a district event at Rough Wood in the new year.
Project initially arranged and designed by local teacher, Chris McCartney of OD.
Also developed by BOF, with funding through Walsall MBC and Walton Chasers.
Control installation by Barry McGowan HOC and Walsall Countryside services and volunteers.

Parking:

Free car park for 30 vehicles, limited height entry. Also roadside parking.

Terrain:

Reclaimed land, now a nature reserve 1k by 0.5k. Wooded, open and rough open areas.
Ponds and marshes. Good path network in most areas.
Vegetation presently thick in places, but courses designed to avoid.

Map:

A4 size 1:5000 map, 2.5m contours. New 2008 map by Peel Land Surveys.
Courses overprinted but needing plastic bag protection.

Courses:

Orange (medium), Green and Blue (difficult)
Yellow (easy and beginners) course may be available

Entries:

On the day only

Registration:

5pm-7pm

Starts:

5pm-7pm

Punching:

List of controls given for you to add control code on visiting.

Fees:

Seniors £3 Juniors £1

Dogs:

Dogs welcome but tethered horses may be met en route.
