- Venue & Travel:** Small but nice municipal park.  
Directions: Off the A448 Kidderminster Road 300m west of its junction with the B4091.  
Entrance to car park at GR S0954707, nearest postcode B61 7JP.
- Parking:** Free parking for park visitors. Go through the first car park and bear right into the second one to get closest to assembly/start/finish.
- Terrain:** Attractive and well-maintained municipal park. Mostly open with small areas of woodland. Good path network and mown grass make for generally easy running in high summer.
- Map:** 1:3000, 2m contours, A4 size. Original survey Graham Gristwood 2008 with additions by John Embrey 2013. Recent updates by Paul Basher.  
Maps home printed - some clear pockets will be available for weather protection.
- Courses:** One course only, 5.5km, 40m climb, 29 controls. Linear score format; participants have 60 minutes in which to visit as many controls as possible in the correct order. Controls can be skipped but can't be visited later if you have time left. 10 points gained per control in order, 1 point per six seconds or part thereof deducted for finishing over the time limit. For example, 1-2-5-7-8-9 scores 60 and so does 1-2-5-7-8-9-6 (as 6 is out of order).
- Entries:** On the day
- Registration:** 1000 - 1200hrs      **Starts:** 1030 - 1230 hrs.
- Punching:** Electronic Punching using SportIdent. SI-Cards may be hired for £1.00
- Fees:** Seniors £4      Juniors £1
- Dogs:** Welcome. Please keep them under control and clear up any mess. Suitable bins are provided for deposit of same.
- Facilities:** Café serving light refreshments and gelati. Toilets.
